Important

You no longer have to reapply as we are able to carry out an audit check from time to time on your eligibility status. However, as soon as your circumstances change, for example, if you start to receive Working Tax Credits or you stop receiving any of the qualifying benefits, you must notify us by phoning 0345 155 1019. We will then inform your child(ren)'s school.

We are not informed automatically if your circumstances change and you no longer qualify for Free School Meals.

*Applications for Free School Meals are administered by Devon County Council for state-funded schools. You should apply to Devon if your child(ren) attend a Devon school - with the exception of **Buckland Brewer Community Primary School**, **Colyton Grammar School, Parkham Primary School, Shirwell Community Primary School** and also **West Exe Childrens Centre Nursery** to which you must apply direct.

Devon is also responsible for Free School Meals applications for **Plymstock School**, **Coombe Dean School** and **Oreston Community Academy**. If your child attends one of these schools, you need to apply to Devon.

How do I qualify?

If you receive **any** of these benefits you will be entitled to Free School Meals:

* Income-based & Contribution-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA) or Employment and Support Allowance (ESA) on an equal basis

- * Income Support (IS)
- * Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (IBJSA)
- * Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (IRESA)
- * Child Tax Credit (without Working Tax Credit) and with an annual taxable income assessed by HM Revenue and Customs to be less than £16,190
- * Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit

* Where a parent is entitled to a Working Tax Credit run-on (the payment received for a further 4 weeks when no longer qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

* Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

Pupil Premium is additional funding given to state-funded schools in England to raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils and close the gap between them and their peers. The criteria for Pupil Premium are the same as for Free School Meals (see Page 1). If we authorise your child's Free School Meals claim, it means that the school is able to receive the Pupil Premium funding for your child.

Universal Free School Meals All children in Key Stage 1 are automatically entitled to a free school meal. If you apply for Free School Meals for a child in KS1, we will check your entitlement for Pupil Premium only and inform the school that your child is eligible for the Pupil Premium. You can speak with the school directly to find out how they use the funding. Please note that we will not respond to your application for Free School Meals for a child in KS1 if he or she is already entitled to a free school meal. Even so, we ask all parents to complete this form as it enables schools to know about every child on roll who is eligible for the Pupil Premium additional funding.

You do not need to send evidence of your qualifying benefit(s) with this application. If we need evidence at a later date, we will contact you.
